

MSU Vesta-linked Accelerated Master's Degree Program

Track 2 – Internship

A fall semester internship in wine production (Internship 6 credits; 480 hours; 12 weeks) OR a winter/spring or summer/fall internship in grape production (Internship 6 credits; 480 hours; 12 weeks) must be completed at the Missouri State Fruit Experiment Station at Mountain Grove in this program track. On-campus housing is usually available and fees are waived if specific maintenance tasks are completed weekly.

This internship and resulting report will be done during the Internship (6 credits) and Seminar (2 credits) courses. An internship journal and a 5-page paper on the internship experience or a specific topic related to the internship is required. The journal must include regular entries and photographs. The journal can be handwritten, written in Microsoft word, or written online in a Blackboard blog. A seminar presentation of this work to the graduate committee is required to be completed prior to graduation.

32 graduate level credits are need to complete this degree with at least 16 credits need to be at the 700 level or higher.

The undergraduate Vesta courses that are linked to the MSU graduate courses must also be completed as well as the Vesta prerequisites.

Program cost for 32 MSU Graduate credits is estimated at	\$ 8,600
The separate program cost of the linked undergraduate Vesta courses is estimated at	\$ 5,800
The total cost of the MSU Vesta-linked master's program is estimated at	\$14,400
